As a top rider, you just have to be here

Maikel van der Vleuten has been one of the favourites of the enthusiastic audience at the Brabanthallen for years. "The Dutch Masters is an event where you want to start as a top rider. The organisation has everything just right for the horses, the riders and the audience. There is really nothing to complain about. On Sunday, I will start with Dywis in the Rolex Grand Prix. I have been riding the 12-year-old mare for 1.5 years now. The performance is not 100% stable at the highest level yet but she is improving by leaps and bounds. So I am definitely not without a chance and of course I am extra motivated because I am starting here in front of my own public."

"In Den Bosch, you have to go for it!"

"If you want to win them all, you have to start at the first one," grinned Piet Raijmakers jr. yesterday, after winning the 1.40m opening class. Speed is Piet's thing, the audience at The Dutch Masters has witnessed that several times. Just like now, and clear. With his mare Van Schijndel's Olaya Z (by Ogano Sitte), he shot through the second phase in 22.45 seconds without touching the wood. In doing so, he narrowly beat Henk van de Pol with Cayenne de Clarence (by Baloubet du Rouet), followed by Martin Fuchs and The

Sinner (by Sanvaro). Piet: "As a Brabander, you just have to go for it in Den Bosch! And all the better if that results in a victory." Today the audience can enjoy the goodhumoured Brabander again, as one of his favourite events is on the programme: the Van Schijndel Bouwgroep Indoor Derby promises to be a true spectacle as ever. Piet is also counting on his fast and agile mare for this course, so who knows what we will be treated to...
