

Gemeente 's-Hertogenbosch Prize

The Gemeente 's-Hertogenbosch Prijs is an annual class that in previous years was won by big names in the sport such as Frenchman Julien Epaillard, Maikel van der Vleuten, Brazilian Marlon Modolo Zanotelli and Belgian Nicola Philippaerts who even managed to win it twice in a row. Last year, Italian Lorenzo de Luca won with his then 11-year-old mare Dirka de Blondel.







The very first edition of the HeadFirst Group Prize - Best of Champions was a resounding success. In this unique class, in which riders changed horses, Dutch champion Willem Greve ran away with the win. European silver medallist Philipp Weishaupt came second and also brought along the best horse of the evening: Cupido 130 who delivered purely clear rounds tonight. World champion Henrik von Eckermann was third, ahead of Olympic medallist Maikel van der Vleuten. Initiator Jeroen Dubbeldam gloated afterwards: 'I had not dared to dream this! The audience was a listening ear, they were mouse quiet but in the nicest way - they were observing. The skill of these top riders came out beautifully.'

The best horse of the evening came from the stables of German rider Philipp Weishaupt. His nine-year-old gelding Cupido 130 stayed clear under four different riders and did not even touch a bar. He also delivered a flawless round in the jump-off, but a fraction slower time than Greve eventually gave Weishaupt second place.

World champion Henrik von Eckermann finished third after his experienced mare Calizi dropped a pole in the jump-off. Maikel van der Vleuten cleverly rode three clear rounds, but missed the jump-off due to eight penalties with Calizi. Van der Vleuten's nine-year-old mare Lalique deserves a special mention: with four clear basic rounds and nothing but praise from her guest riders, she proved her quality.

National showjumping and dressage riders in the spotlight

On Friday, the best national showjumping and dressage riders will compete in arena 2 at The Dutch Masters. The jumping riders will kick off at 11.30 a.m. and in the evening the dressage riders will compete for honours. For the jumping competitions, the ten highest placed 1.30m competitors of the Brabantse Indoor Region Championships 2025 have qualified plus the first three highest placed 1.30m competitors of the Region Indoor Championships 2025 of the other 10 Regions in the Netherlands. In dressage, 13 competitors qualified for both Z2 and ZZ-Light: The three highest-placed Z2 competitors from the Brabant Indoor Region Indoor Championships 2025 and the highest-placed (champion) Z2 participant from the Regional Indoor Championships 2025 of the other 10 Regions in the Netherlands (10 participants). Last year, Niek van Wylick (pictured) won the 1.30m with Halla. This year, the combination is on the starting list for the 1.35m.




